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Classroom Policies

- Class begins when the bell rings. Students not in their assigned seats when the bell rings will be marked tardy. Three tardies result in a discipline referral. If students are on task and time is permitting, the passing period may be used as a quick break for students to use the restroom and/or getting a drink.
- Food, gum, and drinks (other than water) are prohibited in the classroom.
- Speaking out of turn, rudeness, and other disruptive behavior will result in detention after school.

Continuance of unacceptable behavior will result in:

1. a phone call home
 2. a parent conference
 3. a referral
- Every person in the classroom is expected to treat all others with the consideration and dignity they themselves expect.

Course Requirements

- notebook with eight dividers (labeled in this order: management, spelling, grammar, literature, writing, history notes, history assignments, history quizzes/tests)
- binder paper (binder...no “fuzzy” spiral bound edges)
- writing utensil (pencil or blue/black ballpoint ink pen)
- red ballpoint pen/pencil (no highlighters or felt tip pens)

Make-up work: For each day of excused absence from class, you will receive one day in which to catch up on missed assignments. Assignments will be posted in the classroom and online. Late work will be accepted for 50% credit for the duration of the quarter. Homework that is graded in class regularly (e.g. spelling) will not be accepted as late work. If you develop a difficulty printing out an assignment from home (e.g. an essay), you should e-mail the assignment as an attachment to the teacher and bring in a note from your parent verifying the situation (broken printer, paper shortage, etc.). Long term homework assignments are expected to be submitted upon your return to the classroom.
